# a quick checklist



### **General Guidelines**

- · Be concise but descriptive..
- Focus on essential information the user needs.
- · Avoid phrases like "image of" or "graphic of."



#### **Images & Graphics**

- Describe content and function (e.g., chart trends, action in photo).
- Include text in images if it conveys important information.
- Skip decorative images (or mark as decorative).



# **Charts & Graphs**

- Explain key data and trends, not every number.
- · Include units and context if needed.
- Ensure meaning is clear without seeing the visual.



## **Complex Images**

- Use a short alt text plus a longer description if needed.
- Consider linking to a full description for detailed visuals.



Remember, accessibility isn't only a checkbox, it's just how we do things.
